The safety is important, but so is mobility. Balancing these two values in an automobile-dependent world is the highest priority. Driving is a very complex task. Understanding all of the factors that make it possible to drive safely and that may present barriers to a driver continuing to drive safely requires specialized training and education by specifically trained therapists. Occupational Therapists with such specialized training in driver rehabilitation are able to identify not only a driver's strengths but also the physical, visual, and cognitive challenges the individual faces. As a result, specifically trained OT's can evaluate an individual's overall ability to operate a vehicle safely and, if needed, recommend ways to limit risks. Occupational Therapists have the extensive training and knowledge needed to recognize the impact of medical conditions and the aging process on driving performance. They use skill-building, behavioral, and adaptive approaches to keeping a person mobile in his or her community, even if he or she must limit or stop driving. After the success of first COTE on Driver Rehabilitation, Academic Council of Occupational Therapy is organizing COTE on "Driver Rehabilitation" for 2nd time in Mumbai.

This academic oration, demonstration and practical sessions will be followed with assessment of performance: by experienced teaching faculty of AIIPMR, Mumbai
