The nominations/recommendations should be sent for the following specific awards

- 1) AIOTA'S YOUNG OT ACHIEVER AWARD
- 2) AIOTA's PROFESSIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD
- 3) AIOTA'S LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Life time Achievement Award may also be conferred posthumously to honor the life time contribution of an OT professional of repute.

The recommendations/ Self nominations supported by brief resume & related documents should reach by email to the President AIOTA, Dr Anil Srivastava (president@aiota.org) & Convener, Award screening committee, Dr Jyothika Bijlani (deanacot@aiota.org) by 30th September for awards to be conferred in forth coming OTICON .

The Screening Process

Screening Committee of AIOTA Awards will examine all the CVs & documents & will decide the awards on their merits.

- 1. Candidate scoring highest credit points as per scoring criteria will be preferred
- 2. The Convener of the Award Screening Committee would submit the report.
- 3. Decision of award screening committee of AIOTA shall be final and binding.
- 4. Honorary secretary of AIOTA will send letter of information to all awardees.
- 5. The awardees will be presented an Award Trophy/Memento carrying the name and certificate.
- 6. The awards will be presented during the annual national conference of AIOTA.

Essential Eligibility Criteria

Indian National
Life Member of AIOTA
Max. 35 years of Age (age proof to be attached)

PRIMARY CRITERIA (Mandatory)

Any meritorious or professional activity/awards/achievements at the local, Branch, State, National and /or International Level which is duly recognized by Bodies of State, National and/or International repute.

SECONDARY CRITERIA

Regular contribution for the up gradation of Occupational Therapy Profession in the form of

- Research work and Presentations at National and/or International Level
- > Publications in Indexed Journals and Books

AIOTA's PROFESSIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD

Essential Eligibility Criteria

Indian National
Life Member of AIOTA
Min. 35 years of Age & maximum age 59 yrs
Attended at least 5 AIOTA conferences

PRIMARY CRITERIA (Mandatory)

Regular contribution for the up gradation of Occupational Therapy Profession in the form of

- ➤ Worked for AIOTA as elected/nominated positions in EC of AIOTA/ACOT/IJOT
- Any meritorious or professional activity OR contribution in any type of Professional, Clinical, Academics and/or Administration

SECONDARY CRITERIA

Research work and Presentations at National and/or International Level

AND/OR

➤ Publications in Indexed Journals and Books

AND/OR

➤ Reviewer for IJOT and other Indexed Journals

AND/OR

Faculty for State, National and/or International Conferences/ COTE etc.

AIOTA'S LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Essential Eligibility Criteria

Indian National
Life Member of AIOTA
Min. 60 years of Age
Attended at least 10 AIOTA/National /International conferences

PRIMARY CRITERIA (Mandatory)

Regular contribution for the up gradation of Occupational Therapy Profession in the form of

- Contribution in any type of Professional, Clinical, Academics and/or Administration
- Any meritorious or professional activity/awards/Achievements at the Local, Branch, State, National and /or International Level which is duly recognized by Bodies of State, National and/or International Repute.
- Contribution to AIOTA as elected/nominated positions in EC of AIOTA/ACOT/IJOT

SECONDARY CRITERIA

- Research work and Presentations at National and/or International Level AND/OR
- Publications in Indexed Journals and Books

AND/OR

➤ Reviewer for IJOT and other Indexed Journals

AND/OR

Faculty for State, National and/or International Conferences/ COTE etc.
