THE DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR AMENDMENT IN REHABILITATION COUNCIL OF INDIA (RCI) ACT 1992

The addition of occupational therapy (OT) categories in the proposed amendment act of RCI, which seems to be irrelevant, unnecessary and uncalled for, has been resented by the All India Occupational Therapists' Association (AIOTA). The AIOTA submitted strong representation with request to delete the clauses in Schedule 1-xxi & 2-vii of the draft proposal, in respect to the inclusion of the profession of occupational therapy and occupational therapy assistants under the purview of RCI. The reasons being that occupational therapists and physiotherapists were not considered as rehabilitation professionals in the light of Notification no. 674 Dated 13-10-98 duly notified in Gazette of India dated 25 June 1999, which was after a written petition by the AIOTA in Honorable High Court, New Delhi.

THE DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF DISABILITY STUDIES & REHABILITATION SCIENCES BILL 2021

The AIOTA appreciated the move to have more OT colleges imparting BOT, MOT and PhD. programs in the proposed 'University of Disability Studies & Rehabilitation Sciences Bill 2021, introduced recently by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. It aims for developing human resources for their treatment and effective rehabilitation and wellbeing of the disabled. This provision is likely to create opportunities for more occupational therapy colleges thereby enhancing human resource of qualified occupational therapists practicing to offer specialised services to the disabled population of the country. However the shortcomings of the Bill have been addressed in the AIOTA representation like - the standards of OT courses should come under the ambit of the proposed National Allied and Health Care Commission. Further, the courses should also be endorsed by the Academic Council of Occupational Therapy (ACOT), MOT in different speciality areas of OT, as are available in many of the universities in India and overseas and one member from national association (AIOTA) should also be included in the Proposed court to review and advise on the policies and programs of the university in respect to the OT.

WFOT COUNCIL MEETING

COVID-19 pandemic continues to escalate in many parts of the world. The World Federation of Occupational Therapists (WFOT) council meeting which was to be held in August, 2020 will now be held online on the 19th January, 2021. Election for new WFOT executive management team will also be held.
